	<b>1.1</b> 1 Point: Article meets all specified criteria (relevance, credibility, publication date, length, complexity). Submitted to the shared folder by the deadline.
	<b>1.2</b> 0.5 Points: Article meets most criteria, but there may be minor issues with one or two aspects (e.g., slightly older publication date, length slightly outside the recommended range). Submitted by the deadline.
	<b>1.3</b> 0 Points: Article does not meet several criteria, is not submitted to the shared folder, or is submitted significantly late.
2.	Question Formulation - 1 point
	<b>2.1</b> 1 Point: Formulates 3 insightful and thought-provoking questions that encourage critical thinking and reflection on the article's topic. Questions are clearly related to the article's core themes and demonstrate an understanding of discourse analysis prin
	<b>2.2</b> 0.5 Points: Formulates 1-2 questions that encourage critical thinking and reflection on the article's topic, yet they may lack depth or complexity. Connection to discourse analysis could be stronger.
	2.3 0 Points: Questions are superficial, irrelevant to the article's main points
